Edward Monokian of Southampton Twp. died Saturday May 16th, 2009 at the Samaritan Hospice Unit at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 85. Mr. Monokian was born in Brooklyn, NY, the son of the late Harry and Agnes Sahagian Monokian. He served in the United States Marine Corps and received the Purple Heart Medal while in the South Pacific during World War 2. Mr. Monokian was the former owner, with his brothers George and John , of Monokian Rugs in Pennsauken , he later owned Central Auto and Tire Store in Blackwood and finished his business career as the owner of Holly News and Cards in Mount Holly. Active in Masonic life he was past Master of the Haddonfield- Cherry Hill Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons and was Past Grand Chaplain of the Grand Lodge of New Jersey. Mr. Monokian was a member of the Burlington Country Club.

Mr. Monokian is survived by his wife Veronica Sarkisian Monokian, three sons Harry (Cindy) of Voorhees, Robert (Jeanne) of St. Croix, VI, and Ronald (Joy) of Lumberton, NJ, five grandchildren: David, Michael (Jessica), Brandon, Jake and Meghan and many nieces and nephews.
