Born in Bayonne, Mr. Porr was an Air Force Veteran and was an Engineer on McGuire Air Force Base for many years. He later was an Associate at the Alaimo Group in Mount Holly and was the township Engineer for several local towns in the South Jersey area. Ed was a longtime member of Easton Bible Church and previously the First Baptist Church of Mount Holly and volunteered in various roles in both churches. Ed enjoyed fishing, boating, and the beach.

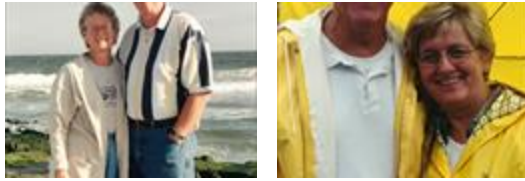

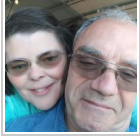
I am so very sad to hear of the passing of your father. I had no idea he was even sick.
