Elaine Goes, age 85 of The Masonic Village in Burlington, NJ, formerly of Willingboro, NJ, died January 8, 2024, at Samaritan Hospice in Mt. Holly. Her last several years were a physical and mental struggle from which she is now free.

Elaine was a Homemaker, the business manager/bookkeeper and business partner until 1996 when they sold the business. Shortly after selling the business, they divorced.

Elaine could not pass up a good dessert; in fact, she could make an entire dinner out of dessert. She enjoyed socializing with friends and dining out. She liked to shop for clothes. 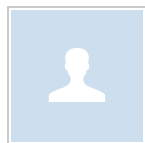
