Jean Scrimale of Moorestown, NJ went home to be with the Lord on Friday, September 22, 2023. She was 91.

Jean was born on April 17, 1932 in Grapeville, PA, the daughter of Ralph and Mary Saltzman. She was the youngest of 8 children. In 1953 she graduated Cum Laude from Eastern Bible Institute, where she was the class speaker. She married Charles “Chuck” Scrimale in 1954 and they began their 61 years of ministry together. They pioneered their first church in Mt. Holly, NJ, which later became Lighthouse Tabernacle. They also pastored in Staten Island NY, Carthage NY, Mt. Ephriam NJ, Blackwood NJ, Broadheadsville PA and finally retired in 2015, from the Pastoral Staff at Lighthouse Tabernacle in Mt. Holly, NJ.

Jean enjoyed being with her family, especially shopping with her daughters at the Pocono Outlets. She also enjoyed hosting dinner events, whenever possible, and playing the piano. She taught piano lessons for many years and was a Pre-school teacher at Bethel Christian Academy. Nothing brought her more joy than serving the Lord and His people.
