



## Elton P Jordan

Elton P. Jordan of Hainesport died Monday, December 2, 2013 at Virtua-Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 85.

Born in Medford, Mr. Jordan was a longtime resident of Hainesport. He was a graduate of Mount Holly High School and was active with various reunion committees. Elton served in the US Air Force and is a Veteran of the Korean War. After his discharge from the service he worked on the McGuire AFB and retired as an Instrument Shop Foreman.
