Floyd A. "Sonny" Goff Jr. of Mt. Holly went home to be with his Lord and Savior Thursday, June 30, 2011. He was 72. Born in Camden, he was a lifelong Mt. Holly resident. After serving his country in the National Guard for four years and then the US Coast Guard for four years, participating in the rescue of the crew of the MV Helga Smith, he decided to dedicate his service to his local community by serving as a Mt. Holly Police Officer for eleven years and later a Supervisor for Burlington County Central Communications for 25 years.

Sonny also volunteered at the Burlington County Library for a year doing genealogy work. Being a Born Again Christian, he spent many summers donating his time with his wife at Teen Mission Int'l in Merritt Island, FL. He was a big sports fan and especially loved baseball and the Phillies. Sonny loved trips to Disney World with his family and will always be remembered as a cheerful and kind man. He recently signed on to Facebook and quickly gained a large following of people who always enjoyed and will miss his daily posts regarding the town and his outlook on life.
