



Francesco DeLucia

June 26, 1926 - January 29, 2015

Francesco “Frank” DeLucia, age 88, passed away in the early morning hours on Thursday, January 29, 2014, at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly, New Jersey, with his son by his side.

Born June 26, 1926, in Capua, Italy, Frank was the son of the late Salvatore and Gabriella (Addelio) DeLucia. As a young man, Frank was a police officer with the Polizia Stradale – the National Highway Patrol of Italy, a sub-directorate of the Italian State Police – and was assigned to Modena, Italy, for several years. In 1957, he met and fell in love with Philomena Scialdone who was visiting family in Italy near Frank’s hometown of Capua. The two soon married and Frank left Italy and moved to Glens Falls, New York, in 1958. He was a longtime machine operator for the Glens Falls Cement Company and a member of the Sons of Italy and the Elks Lodge. He moved to the Mount Holly area about 8 years ago to be closer to his children.

Frank is survived by his wife of 56 years, Philomena; daughter and son-in-law: Anna Maria & Paul Schatzel of Eastampton; son Salvatore (Sal) of Eastampton; and three grandchildren: Alexa, Andrew, & Michael. In addition he leaves behind one brother, four of six sisters, and one sister-in-law.
