



## Frank A. Casano Sr

June 3, 1946 - October 17, 2014

Frank Casano of Southampton, passed away peacefully early Friday morning with his loving family by his side. He fought a valiant and courageous seven month battle with Acute Myeloid Leukemia.

Born in New York City to Joseph and Genevieve Casano on June 3, 1946, the family moved to Mount Holly the same year. The family owned and operated Joe's Mobil Service and later became Casano Brothers Auto Repair.

Frank leaves behind his beloved wife of 47 years, Carol, his devoted children, Frank Jr and his wife Jennifer of Tabernacle, and daughter Christine and her husband Jeffrey Barnes of Marmora, NJ.

Left to cherish his memory, Frank leaves his loving grandchildren Frank Casano III, Joshua Barnes, Nicholas Casano, Jackson Barnes and Mary Casano.

Frank was predeceased by his brother and forever buddy, Joseph C. Casano. Remaining to hold him in memory are Frank's "sister" Natalie Casano, niece Brenda Jo Lehner (Kris), nephew Joseph Casano (Brenda Lynn), and their children Gina and Kris Lehner and Joseph and Bella Casano, Frank's "sister" Cherie Corbett (Jim) and nephews Matthew, Justin and Andrew Corbett. Frank graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School in 1965 where he was an athletic standout in football and wrestling and became District

Frank's passion was his family and time spent with them was always a top priority. An avid outdoorsman, Frank and his family enjoyed caring for his property, the beach, surf and bay fishing, cycling and kayaking. Special times with his grandchildren were the best of the best to Frank. He lovingly and proudly attended sports event, dance recitals, school activities and always celebrated with ice cream at Evergreen in Southampton or Kessel's Corner in Ocean City. 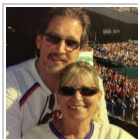
