



Frank Hood

December 11, 1937 - October 23, 2015

Frank Hood passed away peacefully at his home in Columbus, NJ on Friday, Oct. 23, 2015 surrounded by his family. He died from complications of kidney disease. He was 77.

He was born in Philadelphia, but left there for Guantanamo Bay, Cuba when he was three months old when his father was transferred there in the Navy. He moved to Key West, FL in 1941 and remained there until he graduated from high school. He attended the University of Florida (Go Gators); graduating in 1960. He met his wife Sue, and they were married in 1957. Frank was a Construction Engineer, working on a myriad of projects ranging from Nuclear Power Plants, bridges, railroad cars and many other things all over the world. But his dream job was the three years he spent working on the Apollo Space Program at Cape Canaveral getting the launch pads ready for flight. He was there from Apollo 7 to Apollo 12. He was transferred to Philadelphia in 1970.

He was predeceased by his parents and his grandson, Dale Edward Heminghaus. He is survived by his wife Sue of 58 years, five children, Margie (Carl), Mark (Kathy), Matt (Linda), Mary (Greg), and Melanie (Dave). He is also survived by his grandchildren: Katie (Ryan) Nase, Emily Ruzicka, Allison Coutts, Dean and Megan Heminghaus, Billy (Jayme) and Stephen Dempster as well as great grandchildren, CJ and Kalynn Nase and Madison Dempster.
