January 31, 1938 - August 15, 2019

Frank L. Leap of Hainesport, died Thursday, August 15, 2019 at his home. He was 81.

Born in Paulsboro, Frank moved to Cumberland Co. at a young age where he worked on 2 dairy farms and attended Woodstown High School. He moved to Lumberton Township and was a graduate of Rancocas Valley High School class of 1957. He worked at a dairy farm and grew tomatoes for Campbells. He joined the Marines in 1960 and was discharged after 2 months for medical reasons. After his discharge he drove a truck in the tri-state area and in 1965 went to work driving for Atlantic Wood Industries in Hainesport for over 40 years.

The husband of the late Linda, who died in 2006; Frank is survived by a son Frank (Tammy) of Manahawkin; a daughter Kathryn McClintock of Southampton; 3 grandsons, 2 granddaughters; and 5 great-grandchildren. He is also survived by 2 brothers Timothy & Walter; a sister Debbie Carter; and a longtime companion Dorothy Baldwin and her 6 children and their families.

Funeral services will be held on Monday at 11:00 AM at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. Friends may visit with the family on Monday from 10-11 AM at the Funeral Home. Burial will follow in Lakeview Memorial Park in Cinnaminson.
