Frank Elden Regn of Lumberton died Wednesday, October 27, 2010 at his residence surrounded by his family. He was 80. Born and raised in Mount Holly, NJ; Mr. Regn was a premier baseball prospect from the area prior to being drafted for the Korean War. After receiving an honorable discharge from the Army, Mr. Regn worked for Alexanders Mill in Mt. Holly and then worked and retired from Tenneco Plastics in Burlington.

Elden enjoyed hunting, fishing, sports, time with family and his grandkids. He enjoyed going to the horse races with Rob Severs. He was a member of the Mt. Holly Moose #737 and the Mt. Holly Elks #848.
