



## Frank Michael Horvath

November 13, 1930 - March 16, 2011

Frank Michael Horvath of Willingboro died Wednesday, March 16th at his residence. He was 80. Mr. Horvath was born in Manhattan, New York City, the son of the late Eugene and Elizabeth Simon Horvath. He was a retired Lt. Col. In the U.S. Air Force and served during the Korea Conflict and the Vietnam War. Following his retirement from the Air Force he was a flight instructor and FAA designated flight examiner for Flight Safety International in Teterboro, New Jersey. He was a member of the Willingboro Neighborhood Watch and was a Friend of Bill.

Mr. Horvath is survived by his wife Paula "Polly"; two children: Dr. Andrea Elizabeth Horvath of Chester Springs, PA, and Michael Paul Horvath and his wife Sofia of Brooklyn Park, MN and three grandchildren: Vanessa Elizabeth, Gabriel Michael and Veronica Sol.
