December 20, 1942 - August 10, 2023

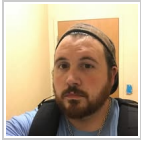
Fred Farrands of Westampton, NJ passed away on Thursday, August 10, 2023 at his home with his wife by his side. He was 80.
