



Frederick G. "Rod" Foote

May 26, 1952 - March 8, 2017

Frederick "Rod" Gerard Foote, 64, passed away peacefully on March 8, 2017, in Mt. Holly, NJ surrounded by his family.

Born in Camden, Rod was a New Jersey native. After being told by his high school guidance counselor that he wasn't "college material," he went on to earn a Bachelors of Arts from Montclair State College, an MBA in Business Administration (Accounting) from the University of Phoenix & became a member of the National Association of Enrolled Agents.

Rod served in the United States Marine Corps as a Communications Specialist from 1970-72. A Corporal upon his honorable discharge, he was a recipient of a National Defense Service Medal & Rifle Marksmanship Badge.

In 1986 Rod founded Confidential Tax Service in Edgewater Park, NJ & would remain the driving force behind it for the next 31 years. During its three decades of existence, Rod's practice served over ten thousand customers who will remember him for his kindness, wit, and vigilant dedication to his work.

Rod is preceded in death by his parents, Preston & Audrey Foote, his siblings: Preston "Peck" Foote, John Foote, Mary Foote Tobias, and Susan Foote Price, and his grandson Christopher James "CJ" Hoffman.

Rod is survived by his wife of 33 years, Elizabeth Hartman Foote, his children: Rachael Foote Hoffman Dolan (Sean), Joshua Foote (Alicia), Frederick Gerard Foote II (Angie), and Amanda Foote (Mauro), his niece Jacqueline Hartman, his siblings: Cora Lee Foote Crandall (Robin), Steven Foote, Gregory Foote (Sheila), and William "Brent" Foote (Laurie), and his grandchildren: Faith Hoffman, Sam Hoffman, and Thomas Dolan. Rod is also survived by countless nieces & nephews, and great-nieces & great-nephews spread throughout the United States.

Rod will be remembered by his family & friends for his humor & generosity. He was a dedicated husband, father, grandfather & proud veteran who will be deeply missed by everyone who knew him.
