Fred T. Caruso, of Columbus passed away on Saturday, February 14th at Samaritan Inpatient Hospice at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mt. Holly. He was 82. Born in Natick, MS, he was the Principal of the Bergen County Institute of Technology for over 30 years.

Before becoming Principal, Fred was a history teacher and guidance counselor. He was also the BCIT Coordinator of Adult Customized Training, Past President of the NJ Apprenticeship Coordinators Assoc., and Past President of the NJ Teachers Assoc. of Bergen County.
