Garland G. "Bez" Beslow Jr., of Mt. Holly passed away Sunday, August 4, 2013 at Samaritan Inpatient Hospice in Mt. Holly. He was 47. Born in San Juan, Puerto Rico, he was a US Air Force Veteran who served out of Bader Field in Atlantic City. Upon the completion of his service he then became a Corrections Officer for the Garden State Youth Correctional Facility in Bordentown for over 17 dedicated years and was a member of the PBA Local #105.

Garland loved local Rancocas Valley HS sports and the Philadelphia Eagles, but his true devotion was dedicating his life to his son, Brandon.
