George Wellington Buller III, of Lumberton passed away suddenly on October 25, 2015. He was 62. George was a loving, supportive, and caring husband and father who was very proud to watch his two daughters graduate from Cornell University.

Born in Fort Campbell, KY, he was a US Marine Corps. Veteran who served as an Embassy Guard in Oslo, Norway, Havana, Cuba, and Nicosia, Cyprus. Upon his honorable discharge, he then spent over 38 dedicated years working for the US Postal Service in Bellmawr, NJ.
