George Ely, Jr. of Hamilton Square, formerly of Eastampton, died Friday, February 6 at Arcadia Nursing Home in Hamilton Square. He was 89. Born in Bordentown, Mr. Ely was raised in Delanco and was a US Army Veteran of WW II. He served with the Battery A 526th Rocket Field Artillery Battalion in Naples, Rome, and the Appennines as a Heavy Artillery Gun Crewman. After serving his country, Mr. Ely worked as an Extruder Operator for Rohm and Haas in Bristol, PA where he retired after 35+years. He was a member of Turner's Hall in Riverside.

The husband of the late Mildred Ely, he is survived by two daughters and sons-in-law: Carol and Mike Bongrazio of Hamilton Square, NJ; & Ruth and Ron Parzyck of Browns Mills, NJ, 2 step-children: Murial Hanna of Wildwood and Robert Ely of Mountaintop, PA; 8 grandchildren and several great-grandchildren. He is also survived by a brother Wilbur Ely of Beverly; and two sisters: Catherine Shaw of Town Bank, NJ and Almeda McPeak of West Virginia.

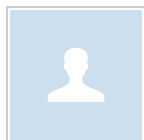
