George H. Shaffer, 81 passed into eternal life peacefully with his wife Joan of 59 years and his family present at his side. George was born in Delanco, NJ and married Joan Heether of Riverside. They built their house and home in Westampton and raised their family of four children. He is survived by his loving wife, Joan and their Chocolate Lab, Coco; daughter and son-in-law, Cindy and Robert Woodington and their son Clayton; son, Rev. G.
