Gerald A. Radcliffe of Lumberton, formerly of Southampton, passed away on Tuesday, January 16, 2018 at the Virtua-Health and Rehab Center in Lumberton. He was 84.

Born in Bridgeboro, NJ, Mr. Radcliff was a longtime resident of Southampton, and served in the US Navy for 4 years. He worked for Mitnick Brothers Cigar Co and later Consolidated Cigar Company.
