Glenn Scott Garber of Daytona Beach, FL died suddenly on January 19, 2009. He was 46. Born in Mount Holly, the son of Joseph R. and Margaret Garber, Glenn was a longtime Mount Holly resident before moving to Florida in 2003. He was a certified plant operator at The City of Daytona Beach Waste Water Treatment Plant and had previously worked for the Mount Holly Sewerage Authority. Glenn was an avid New York Giants fan, loved to play golf and computer games. He taught himself to play the guitar by ear and wrote wonderful poems. He loved all animals, especially his cats.
