Harold Beck Sr., of Burlington Twp. died Thursday September 29th, at the Masonic Home. He was 91. Mr. Beck was born in Browns Mills, the son of the late Robert and Ruth Earlin Beck. He was a 1937 graduate of Pemberton High School and served with the U.S. army in the Philippines in World War 2. He was a retired employee of the Bond Baking Co. and for many years in his retirement he worked at Ted's Liquor Store in Hainesport. Mr. Beck was a former Mayor in Pemberton Boro, a position he held for almost 25 years, and then he served as boro clerk for almost 20 years. He was a member and oldest Past Master of Pemberton Lodge F &AM, a member of the Browns Mills Fire Company, and the N.J. Exempt Firemen's Assoc. Mr. Beck was a former member of the Northampton Treble and Bass Clef Chorus and the Mount Holly Community Band.

Husband of the late Bertha Beck, he is survived by two children: Harold Beck, Jr. and his wife Joan of Mount Laurel, Brenda L. Beck of Burlington, three grandchildren: Brian Beck (Melody) Andrea Wood (Dean), William Roberts (Jessica) and five great grandchildren: Zachary, Joshua, Nicholas, Ryan and Aidan. He is also survived by a brother Kenneth Beck of GA. And a close friend Helen Smith.
