Harry W. Danley, Jr., of Hainesport passed away Tuesday, September 29, 2015 at his home with his brother and sisters by his side. He was 85. Born in Mt. Holly, he was a US Air Force Veteran and lifelong area resident. After his service, he spent many dedicated years as an aircraft mechanic at McGuire AFB. He was also a member of the American Legion.
