Helen C. Smith passed away Tuesday, Oct. 7, 2014, at the age of 92.

She was born Nov. 30, 1921, in Philadelphia, to Joseph Szmyd and Catharina Osetek, and was raised in Burlington. She was preceded in death by her siblings, Sophie, Stanley, Dorothy, August and Violet.

As a young woman, Helen worked for New Jersey Bell Telephone in Mount Holly, first as an operator and then as a floor supervisor. Later in her career, she worked at Nutter Mortgage Agency in Camden.

Helen was like a second mother to all of her nieces and nephews and great-nieces and nephews. She gave her time generously to her family members, broadening their horizons and supporting their individual endeavors.
