



## Helen Elizabeth Heyl

July 4, 1913 - June 2, 2009

Helen Elizabeth (Miss Betty) Heyl of Medford Leas died Tuesday June 2nd 2009 at the Samaritan Hospice Unit at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. She was 95. Miss Heyl was born in Altoona, PA, the daughter of the late Edward R. and Elizabeth Bowen Heyl. With her sister, Caroline, she founded the Buttonwood Nursery and Kindergarten School in Mount Holly in 1952 and they operated the School until retiring in 1982. Miss Betty was a member of the National Society of Colonial Dames in the State of New Jersey and the Thomas Reynolds Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She was a former member of the Board of Directors of the Burlington County Historical Society and St. Mary's Hall in Burlington.

Miss Heyl is survived by her sister Caroline of Medford Leas, a first Cousin, Beverley Heyl Allison and her 4 children of Gordonsville, VA, her close friends Debbie and Keith Halcomb of Browns Mills and her good friend "Rocky".
