



Henry H. Schilder Jr

September 22, 1943 - August 23, 2016

Henry H. "Hank" Schilder Jr. (Corky), 72, of Dallas, Pennsylvania, and formerly of Mount Holly, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday morning, August 23, 2016, at his home with his beloved wife of 11 years, Brenda (Rambo) Schilder, at his side. He epitomized the role of being a loving and devoted husband.

Born on September 22, 1943, in Mount Holly, Hank was the only son of the late Henry H. Schilder Sr. and Claire (Braun) Schilder.

Hank was a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School and Utah State University.

Initially, Hank taught History at Northern Burlington High School. He then joined the Willingboro Twp. Police Department, retiring at the rank of Sergeant after 25 years. He always had great respect and admiration for his fellow brothers and sisters in law enforcement, and was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 38

After retiring from the police force, Hank became an antique dealer in New Jersey at "The Browse Around" and "Country Store Antiques". He and Brenda later relocated to Utah where they owned 2 antique stores, residing there for 12 years. Last year, they moved to Dallas, Pennsylvania, where they planned

to spend their retirement years.

One of Hank's favorite things to do was to "wheel and deal" with S&S Auction in Swedesboro. He will be remembered by his famous saying "Before we do this, would you help me move this piece of furniture? – it'll only take a minute!" Anyone who knew Hank understood that it never just took a minute to move a piece of furniture with him!

In addition to wife, Brenda, Hank is survived by his sons, Bob Schilder and Erik Schilder; as well as many close friends who Hank always considered extended family.
