Henry A. Klimkowski, Sr. formerly of Lumberton, died Wednesday October 6th at the Clarbridge Convalescent Center in Westampton. He was 81. Mr. Klimkowski was born in Philadelphia the son of the late Joseph and Maryanna Klimkowski. For 50 years he owned a vegetable farm in Philadelphia and Lumberton, retiring in 1978. Following his retirement, he worked as an automobile salesman for Miller Ford.

Laurel, William (Joan) Klimkowski of Hainesport, and Rita Simon of Medford; 6 grandsons; 4 granddaughters; 2 great-grandchildren; and a dear friend Kathy Linneman. Yelito.
