



Henry J. Schiavone

October 11, 1939 - October 28, 2008

Henry J. Schiavone of Eastampton died Tuesday October 28th, 2008 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 69. Mr. Schiavone was born in Philadelphia and was raised in Manchester, NH. He joined the United States Army in 1956 and served for almost 22 years before he retired as a First Sergeant. During his time in the service, he served three tours in Vietnam as an Airborne Ranger and was awarded three purple hearts and five bronze star medals and the Army Commendation Medal among many medals. After his retirement from the Army, he served as a Correction Officer with the State Dept. of Corrections, first at the Jamesburg Youth Correction Facility and later at Riverfront State Prison in Camden. Mr. Schiavone loved sports and he was a baseball umpire at many high school games and also at games for the Rancocas Valley League. He was also a member of Board 34 of the Association of Basketball Officials and umpired and officiated softball and basketball games at Fort Dix as a member of Close Call.

Mr. Schiavone is survived by his wife Hannelore; four children: Robert and Henry of New York City, Patricia McDermott and her husband Damien of Stewartsville, NJ and Tony Schiavone and his wife Margaret of Mount Laurel. He is also survived by a grandson Robert Scott, a brother Robert of St. Augustine, FL and several nieces and nephews.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated Tuesday, November 4th at 10AM at Sacred Heart Church, High Street and Bartram Ave., Mount Holly. Interment
