Herbert O. Barraclough, a member of the greatest generation died at Virtua Health and Rehab Center on August 30, 2014. He was 88. Born in Philadelphia, PA in 1926, son of Ruth & Herbert Barraclough, Sr., Herbert was raised in Cherry Hill (Delaware Township) As a youngster and throughout young adulthood, he always had a baseball in his hand. "Red" was an outstanding pitcher.
