



## Herbert S. Angell

April 13, 1923 - November 19, 2013

Herbert S. Angell of Pemberton Township died Tuesday, November 19, 2013 at Virtua-Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 90 years old.

Born in Staten Island, NY, Mr. Angell served seven years in the U. S. Navy (1942-1949). Herb served in the following campaigns: the South Pacific, the Philippines and Rynkus, and he was in the first atomic bomb tests in Bikini, Atoll. He also was commanding officer of three naval vessels with his rank of Lieutenant (Jr.G). After his honorable discharge from the Navy, he returned to Cornell University to complete his college education.

Mr. Angell began his career at H.K. Porter Company Inc. in Riverside, NJ and worked for them for over twenty-nine years. He had numerous positions until he was General Manager. He continued his career until retirement at Branford Wire and Manufacturing Company. Herb also farmed the family farm on Browns Mills-Pemberton Road in Pemberton working at what he loved best – growing flowers, fruit and vegetables. Herb is a member and former Past Commander of the Eden-Stanley Post 294, American Legion in Pemberton.

The husband of the late Agnes Wolfrom, Herbert is survived by his children, Mary Beth Angell of Santa Fe, NM, Barbara Dutton Trombly and her husband, David of Lawrence, MA; Michael & Joanne Britt of Pemberton, NJ; three grandchildren: David Michael, Carleton, & Brittellen; and 10 great-

grandchildren. He is also survived by a sister Althea Milich of Kennewick, WA, several nieces and nephews and many, many cousins.

Funeral services will be held on Monday at 11 AM at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High Street, Mount Holly. Interment with Military Honors will follow in BGWCD Veteran's Memorial Cemetery in Arneytown.
