



H. Francis Pennock

Howard Francis Pennock, Sr. of Southamptton, passed peacefully on Tuesday, October 16, 2012 at his home. He was 82.

Francis was born and raised in Mt. Holly, the son of the late Theodore and Helen (Shumard) Pennock. He was a lifelong Mt. Holly resident until moving to Leisuretowne in Southamptton.

He was a plumber by trade, starting his career with Elmer Grover Plumbing in Mt. Holly. He was a lifelong member of the Union Fire Company, serving as Chief Engineer and a Trustee. He served as Chief from 1981 to 1983. He was also a member of the Burlington County Chief's Association, the Mt. Holly Firemen's Association, and New Jersey Exempt Firemens' Association. He was honored for 14 years of outstanding service as Chief Engineer and in 1974 he received the "Volunteer Fireman of the Year" award from the Schaefer Brewing Company. At the end of his career he retired as a plumber for Burlington County.

Francis was preceded in death by his wife Alberta V. (Stevens) Pennock, his son, Theodore "Teddy" Pennock and his siblings Emma, Joseph, Harold, Ed, Lawrence, and Pete.
