Howard W. Coles passed away Sunday, June 2, 2019 at his home in Mount Laurel. He was 94.

Born October 2, 1924, in Riverton, NJ, the son of Raymond W. and Evelyn (Hubbs) Coles. His parents and brothers Raymond D. Coles, Earl G. Coles, & Marvin W.
