Irma Marshall, of Bordentown, formerly of Columbus, passed away on Saturday, April 6, 2019 at the Clare Estate. She was born April 3, 1922 in Bremen, Germany to Ferdinand and Martha Husung. She arrived at Ellis Island as a toddler with her mother, grew up in New York City, and, in 1949, married Howard J. Marshall.

Irma worked for the International Paper Company until adopting two children in the early 1960s. She became a stay at home mom, and was present in every aspect of their lives: field trips, 4H, Little League games, swim meets, and countless piano recitals and band concerts. She hated cooking, and it showed; but it was more than made up for with the love and support she gave her children, her beloved dog Schatzie, and countless cats.

After the death of her husband of almost 50 years, Irma started living. She volunteered at the polls on Election Day and at Virtua Hospital in Mount Holly, was active at Calvary Lutheran Church in Medford, and participated in line dancing, the Homestead Follies and the Travel Troupe. At age 78, Irma discovered tap dancing. It gave her immense joy, and she danced until she was 90.

Irma is survived and will be missed by her daughter Patte (Michael) Hadfield and son Luke Marshall.
