



## J. Domer Zerbe Jr.

J. Domer Zerbe, Jr. "Dutch" of Cherry Hill passed away on Tuesday, November 21, 2017 at the Collingswood Manor. He was 95.

Born in Philadelphia, Mr. Zerbe grew up in Mount Holly and was a 1939 graduate of Rancocas Valley High School and a 1943 graduate of Rutgers University in New Brunswick. Domer served in the US Army in WW II from 1943-1945 and earned the Bronze Star.

After being honorably discharged from the Army, Domer worked for DuPont Chemical as a marketing representative for 39 years. He was a nature lover and enjoyed birding. Domer taught Sunday School for many years and has served as a board member of the Burlington County Library. He attended Trinity Presbyterian Church in Cherry Hill.

Domer is survived by his wife of 74 years, Jeanette; 3 sons: Domer D. Zerbe and his wife Linda of Eastampton, Wayne N. Zerbe & Stephen L. Zerbe of Cherry Hill; 2 grandchildren: Brad & Kim; and 3 great-grandchildren: Gregory, Zachary, & Sarah. He was the brother of the late Elaine Davies.

Funeral Services will be held on Monday at 12 Noon at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. Friends may visit on Monday from 11am – 12 Noon at the Funeral Home. Interment with military honors will follow in the Mount Holly Cemetery.
