John Wesley "Wes" Goodfellow, Jr. of Mount Holly, died Sunday, July 19, 2015 at Virtua-Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 76.

Born in Philadelphia, Wes was a longtime area resident. He was a US Navy Veteran and a retired Detective Sergeant with the Westampton Township Police Department. After his retirement, he started his own animal control business in the area.


