Chief MSGT James L. Bullock Jr. (Ret.) of Columbus, NJ, sunrise November 7, 1919, in Los Angeles, CA, sunset, July 6, 2014 in Lumberton, NJ. He was 94.

Mr. Bullock was a retired Chief MSgt in the US Air Force. He served Army Air Corps during WW II and some of his campaigns included Bismarck Archipelago, Guadalcanal, and the Northern Solomons. Mr. Bullock retired from the service in 1962. He was also the Past Commander of the DAV Post #27 in Pemberton, NJ and was a member of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Mount Holly.

He is survived by his wife Dorothy; son James L. Bullock III, of Columbus; a daughter Jeannine Leonard of Willingboro, 3 grandchildren, and 6 great-grandchildren. He was the father of the late John Bullock.

Funeral Services will be held on Wednesday at 12 Noon at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, 121 High St., Mount Holly.
