



James Logan Jr.

April 2, 1921 - October 2, 2017

James Logan, Jr. of Westampton, passed away on Monday, October 2, 2017 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 96.

Born April 2, 1921 in Mount Holly, NJ to Christiana Logan and James Logan, Sr., Jim was a 1938 graduate of Rancocas Valley High School and a 1940 graduate of the Episcopal Academy. He graduated from Harvard, the class of 1944 and enjoyed playing many intramural sports while at Harvard. He attended Penn and Rutgers Law School and passed the Bar in 1950.

Mr. Logan was a proud and decorated Marine. He enlisted in the US Marine Corps in 1942, and was called to active duty in 1943. Served in WW II in the Philippines and Japan. He stayed in USMC Reserves at Willow Grove Naval Station and was called back to active duty for Korean Conflict for three years. He later returned to Willow Grove Naval station in the Reserves and retired from the Marine Corps as a Lt. Col after 20 years and 2 months and many awards and decorations.

Mr. Logan started his law firm in Mount Holly on his return from Korea and has practiced in the same building on High Street for over 60 years.

Jim was an active Member of the American Bar Association and Member and Past President of the Burlington Co. Bar Association. He was Chairman of the

Burlington County Young Republicans for 3 years; in 1953 he was a Young Republican Candidate for Assembly; also a member of the Republican County Committee. Locally was a member of the Mount Holly Elks, the VFW, Marine Corps Reserves, the Mount Holly Lions and other civic and fraternal organizations. He was a member of the St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Mount Holly. Jim was a longtime member of Burlington Country Club and enjoyed playing golf with his friends.

He is survived by his wife of 64 years Lois Parker Logan. The father of the late James Logan, III and Ross M. Logan; Jim is also survived by 3 children: Tera Logan, Michael R. Logan and his wife Charlotte, and Holly Logan and her fiancé Richard Mellon; 9 grandchildren: James Logan IV, Emilee Kaplan, Albert James Logan, Brianna Logan, Brittany (Robert) Moore, Kendall Logan & her fiancé Nathaniel Woolen, Michel Read Logan, Nicole Logan Sellar, and Ross Everett Kaplan; 2 great-grandchildren: Lily Ann Moore and Madelynn Logan. He was the brother of the late Grace Hoffaker.

Funeral Services will be held on Saturday at 11:00 AM at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, 121 High St., Mount Holly. Burial in Mount Holly Cemetery will be private. Relatives and friends may visit with the family on Friday evening from 4-7 pm at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly.
