“TO KNOW HER WAS TO LOVE HER”

Jane G. Brooks took her first and last breaths at Virtua Hospital in Mount Holly. She was born on February 13, 1930; the daughter of the late John and Lora Gauntt. She was 87.

She grew up in Hainesport but was a long time resident of Mount Holly. She worked as a valued member in the Guidance Department at Rancocas Valley Regional High School for over 20 years. She was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Night-Outers Club, RV Secretaries' Group and her labor of love was her committee work on the RV Athletic Hall of Fame each year. She married Conly D. Brooks, Jr. on May 12, 1949 at St. Paul's in Hainesport. They lived most of their married life in Mount Holly with the exception of their last five years that were lovingly spent at Brightview, Mt. Laurel.

She is survived by her three children; Conly D. Brooks III, Janice L. Schuler (Warren), and Kathleen B. Adams (Michael); 7 grandchildren, Bre-Lyn Sessions (Neal), Natalie Dubbs (Ken), Conly Brooks IV, Douglass Brooks, Chayla Lyon (Jared), Austin Adams, and Alexa Adams; 5 great-grandchildren, Sydney “Jane” Sessions, Gwendolyn Dubbs, Preston Dubbs, and Milania “Jane” Brooks; Harrison “Conly” Dubbs ; nieces and nephews, Elaine Loboda (Greg), John Gauntt III (Claire), Kevin Gauntt, Melissa Holliday and many




