May 21, 1924 - June 19, 2014

Jean H. Taylor Archer of Mount Holly died suddenly, June 19, 2014 at Virtua-Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. She was 90.

Born in Mount Holly, Jean was a lifelong resident and graduate of Mount Holly High School. During World War II, Jean worked as “Rosie the Riveter” at Fleet Wings in Bristol, PA. She later worked as a Bookkeeper and Accountant for WT Grants in Mount Holly and later for the Mount Holly MUA. Jean was a longtime volunteer for America Emergency Squad where she took emergency calls and dispatched the squad from her home. Jean was also a coordinator for the Burlington County First Aid Council and a coordinator for the State EMT as well as a longtime member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the America Hose Co. Jean was also a longtime active member of the First Baptist Church of Mount Holly where she was a Sunday School teacher, choir member and deaconess.

The wife of the late William Henry Taylor, Jr, who died in 1985, and the wife of the late Milton Archer, she is survived by 3 daughters and sons-in-law: Barbara Jean & the Rev. Bob Santilli of Mount Holly; Edith & Harvey Stratton of Hyde Park, NY; and Marcia & Larry Hunt of Eastampton; 6 grandchildren: Jennifer, Joshua, Glynn Lee, Jessica, Travis & Ryan; and 7 great-grandchildren. She is also survived by a sister-in-law Mildred Richardson and several nieces and nephews.
