Jeffrey I. Matheson, of Lumberton passed away Saturday, August 09, 2014 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mt. Holly. He was 59. A longtime area resident, he dedicated over 36 years working for Burlington County as a Communications Administrator.

Jeffrey was a Past member of the Browns Mills Vol. Fire Co., the US Coast Guard Auxiliary, and the Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service/Amateur Radio Emergency Service. He also served as Radio Producer for the Burlington County College Z88.9 Station.

Son of the late Norman and Helen Matheson, son-in-law of the late Shirley Willitts, he is survived by his wife of over 33 years, Joyce; two daughters, Stephanie Anne Matheson, Allison Marie Loveland and her husband Matthew; and his father-in-law, Kenneth Willitts. Funeral service will be held 11 am, Thursday at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mt. Holly. Interment will follow in the Odd Fellows Cemetery, Pemberton Twp.
