He went out of his way to stop mail easily when we went on vacations and had everything all organized for me when I came home. When we went to VT last summer there had been an issue where our mail was stopped prematurely. He noticed I was home and came to the door. I told him it was no problem, but he picked up my mail and dropped it off at my home on his way home from work. I couldn't believe it, but then again I could because that's how great he was. Regardless of how many packages we got from Amazon, he always delivered them happily saying it was just job security. When we made improvements on the house, he was always excited about them and encouraging. They may sound insignificant but he truly was one of those people who just made your life better. I spoke to him 2 weeks ago and he told me that he wasn't planning on retiring for about 5 more years.
