August 18, 1930 - February 2, 2016

Jesse L. Clayton of Browns Mills passed away Tuesday, February 2, 2016 at Genesis Cooper River West in Pennsauken. He was 85.

Born in Greenville, SC, Mr. Clayton served in the US Air Force during Korea. He later worked for the Pemberton Township Police Department and was known as Sergeant Jesse Clayton. He was the first detective ever on the Pemberton Township Police Department. He was a member and former Deacon at Browns Mills Baptist Church. Jesse was an avid NASCAR fan and used to race mini stock cars in his younger years.

Jesse is survived by his wife of 63 years, Beatrice; 4 children: Jesse (Lily) Clayton Jr. of Laredo, TX; Terry Hadden (Dennis) of Atco, NJ; Lynn (Mohammed) Taher of Kearny, NJ; and Becky Clayton of Browns Mills, NJ; 5 grandchildren & 3 great-grandchildren.

Funeral Services will be held on Monday at 12 Noon at the Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly. Interment with Military Honors will follow at BGWCD Veteran's Memorial Cemetery in Arneytown.
