Jill D. Walley passed away Thursday June 3rd, 2010. She was 57. Raised in Morrisville, PA, she resided in Pemberton, NJ with her beloved husband Richard P. Walley. Jill graduated from Pennsbury High School. She became the first woman Crew Chief at Griffiss Air Force Base in Rome, NY, responsible for two F-106 fighters and she served a tour of duty in Oman in 2002. In New York she opened a novelty balloon store called Peter's Piper. Jill returned to PA and joined her family's business Allied Office Products and also joined the Air National Guard. She retired at McGuire AFB as a Staff Sergeant. Jill enjoyed horses, fishing, singing and playing the guitar.

Jill was predeceased by her mother, Joyce E. Ferguson. She is survived by her husband, Richard Walley, a son Eric Talerico, her father Warren Ferguson and step-mother Anne Ferguson of Yardley, PA and her sisters: Wendi Mershon of Yardley, PA and Janis Nader of New River, AZ and her step-son Richard Walley of Middlesex, NJ.
