



## Joan T Muckelston

February 7, 1933 - July 13, 2015

Joan T. Muckelston of Whiting, formerly of Eastampton, passed away on Monday, July 13, 2015 at Lourdes Hospital in Willingboro. She was 82.

Born in Philadelphia, Mrs. Muckelston was a longtime area resident before moving to Whiting several years ago. She was a longtime active member of the Sacred Heart Church in Mount Holly where she served as a Eucharistic Minister and a member of the Altar Rosary Society.

Mrs. Muckelston was also was a N.J. VFW Ladies Auxiliary Past State President. She was also recognized extensively for community service, work promoting veteran's causes and volunteer work with hospitalized veterans.
