John Ernest Anderson passed away peacefully on Wednesday, April 8, 2015 at the Jacksonville, Fla. home of his daughter and son-in-law, Denise and Lee Pinkerton. He was 89.

Born Jan. 19, 1926 in Camden, N.J., John lived most of his life in Mount Holly, N.J. At 18, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps, rose to the rank of corporal, and proudly served his country during World War II with the 4th Marine Division, 24th Regiment, 2nd Battalion, G Company. He fought courageously in the battle for Iwo Jima and was awarded the Bronze Star Medal for heroic achievement.

His career in the furniture industry began in 1942 with the J. B. VanSciver Company, where he worked for over 42 years. During that time he rose from mail boy to company treasurer.

John was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 65 years, Rose C. (O'Donnell); his daughter, Michelle; his son, Daren; and his parents, Henry M. and Edythe W. Anderson.
