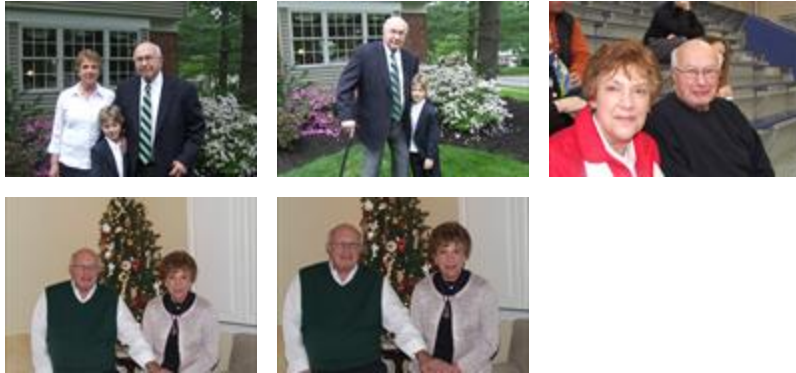


“ *Dear Fran and Family,
