John J. Blazewick of Cherry Hill, formerly of Mount Holly died Tuesday May 7, 2013. He was 30.

Born in Mount Holly, John was a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School. After graduation, he enlisted in the US Marine Corps. John served honorably in the Marines as a Military Police Officer at the Albany, GA logistics base. He was honorably discharged from the Marines in 2005. John earned his Bachelors and Masters degrees from Colorado Tech and was working as a Corrections Officer for the State of NJ at the Albert C. Wagner Correctional Facility in Bordentown.

He is survived by his wife Nancy; his mother Nina Blazewick of Mount Holly; his father Paul Blazewick, Jr. of Southampton; 2 brothers: Paul Blazewick, III of Delanco and David Blazewick of Mount Holly; his sister Karen Calabrese of Middletown.
