John Joseph Goss, Jr. of Mount Laurel, died Friday, February 22, 2013 at the VA Medical Center in Philadelphia. He was 67.

Born in Philadelphia, Mr. Goss grew up in Delanco and was a graduate of Riverside High School. He served in the US Marine Corps Third Division during Vietnam. After serving his country, John worked as a Bill Poster for RC Maxwell in Trenton. He was a member of the Marine Corps Scout and Sniper Association, the Marine Corps League, the Vietnam Veterans of America, and was an avid hunter and fisherman.

Mr. Goss is survived by his wife of 42 years, Deborah N. Goss of Mount Laurel; a daughter and son-in-law: Carriann & James Brennan of Marlton. He was "G-dad" to granddaughter Cecily. John is also survived by several nieces and nephews.

Interment service with military honors will be held on Friday, March 1, 2013 at 11:30 AM at the BGWCD Veteran's Memorial Cemetery Chapel. Vehicles may gather for the procession to the cemetery in the parking lot of the Church of the Assumption, 26 Monmouth Rd, New Egypt at 11:00 AM.
