John M. Cameron of Mount Holly died Saturday, January 5, 2013 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Center at Virtua Memorial Hospital. He was 80. Born in Burlington, Mr. Cameron was a longtime Mount Holly resident. He was a US Army Veteran of Korea and was a longtime area plumber. He had worked for Albert Ellis, Inc, Joseph Vaughn Plumbing and Heating, and for McGuire Air Force Base.
