Born in Philadelphia, PA, in 1953, Joseph grew up in Glassboro, NJ, and dedicated his life to his family, profession, and community. His legacy in academia lives on, as he inspired and encouraged critical thinking, empathy, and understanding in all his students. A lifelong Catholic, Joe's faith was an important part of his life. He lived out his beliefs through his kindness, generosity, and commitment to his community.

He found great comfort in his church family, and his devotion to the teachings of the Church guided him throughout his life.

An avid sports fan, Joe was a lifelong supporter of the Philadelphia Eagles, and his passion for the team was contagious. Whether at home or among friends, he was always "Philly Proud." 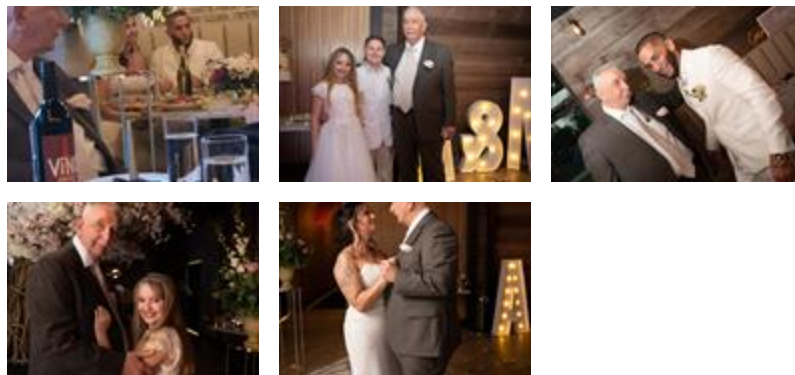
